FCHJA 2009 HORSE OF THE YEAR COMPETITION

Once again, FCHJA is pleased to hold the Horse of the Year Competition. Categories for this will be:

2'-2'3" Riders will compete in the 2' Height Class

2'6"-2'9" Riders will compete in the 2'6" Height Class

3' Riders will compete in the 3' Height Class

In order to qualify for Horse of the Year Competition the horse/rider combination must have received a Champion or Reserve Champion Award at a FCHJA show in a rated hunter division at the applicable height during the current showing season prior to the November 7th show and be a current junior or amateur member of FCHJA. A horse or pony may enter only one Horse of the Year class even though the horse may have qualified in multiple divisions or with multiple riders. No substitute riders will be permitted. Each Horse of the Year class will be one round over fences at the appropriate height. Ribbons and payback to six places will be awarded. The winner at each height will also receive a special prize. Good Luck to everyone!

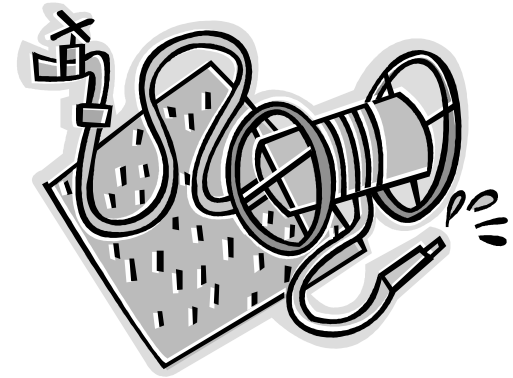

EMT

Horse Show Rules:

1. Management reserves the right to refuse to receive any exhibitor and/or horse before the show and reserves the right to order from the premises during the show any exhibitor or horse without being liable for compensation.
2. First Coast Hunter Jumper Association will not be responsible for any accident or loss occurring to animal, person or property.
3. Proof of negative Coggins will be required of each horse entering the grounds.
4. **All adult and junior riders must wear approved SEI/ASTM protective headgear with fastened safety harness.**
5. Entry fees: All entries except Jumper classes will be \$10.00 per class if entered by Pre-Entry cutoff date. All Post-Entry fees are \$12.00. Jumper Classes will be \$20.00. All 4-H members will receive a \$2.00 per class discount. Entries for special classes will be notated and are subject to change. All horses on the grounds will be charged a \$15.00 administrative/office fee.
6. Exhibitors must leave a signed check or cash for their entries in order to pick up entry numbers. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for all returned checks.
7. Supervised Schooling will be permitted on Friday, 12:00 to 6:00. A \$5.00 schooling fee will be charged as well as a release must be signed for Saturday. Schooling will be permitted Saturday until times posted per ring. A warm-up/schooling area will be provided throughout the show day.
8. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in all divisions; however, Champion & Reserve points **WILL NOT** be awarded in Equitation & Jumper Divisions.
9. **Riders are permitted to enter only one equitation division per show.**
10. Dogs must be kept on a leash and under control at all times while on the show grounds.
11. Show management may designate the order of go.
12. Trainers are responsible to submit their requests for order of go so as to minimize conflicts.
13. A two (2) minute gate call may be enforced.
14. Any act of discourtesy to a judge or any other show official on the part of the owner, trainer, or rider will immediately disqualify any horse associated and all entry fees will be forfeited. No stallions will be shown by junior riders.
15. A dotted line may be enforced.

- **Benefit Shows** – FCHJA will have a minimum of one benefit show each year. Worthy beneficiaries are selected to receive the proceeds of these shows.
- **FCHJA Horse of the Year Show** – This show is held annually in November. Three special horse/pony jumping classes will be held with a monetary payback. **Eligibility requirements are:**
 - 1) **Horse must be owned or leased by a current 2009 FCHJA member**
 - 2) **The rider must be a junior or adult amateur 2009 FCHJA member in good standing.**
 - 3) **The horse/rider combination must have won a Champion or Reserve Champion placing prior to the November Horse Show in a rated hunter division (excluding equitation divisions) at a FCHJA 2009 show. This does not include sanctioned shows.**
 - 4) **A horse or pony may enter only one HOY class even though the horse may have qualified in multiple divisions or with multiple riders. No substitute riders will be permitted. The eligible division heights are 2'0" through 3'0" and class heights will be: 2'3, 2'6, & 3'0.**
- **Point Calculator:** Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. Champion and Reserve points WILL NOT be awarded in Equitation & Jumper Divisions. First through sixth place ribbons will be awarded in each class. To be eligible for year-end awards, membership dues must be paid in advance or points will not count. (First Place – 10 points), (Second Place – 6 points), (Third Place – 4 points), (Fourth Place – 2 points), (Fifth Place – 1 point), (Sixth Place – 0.5 point) Championship of division is 20 points and Reserve is 12 points.
- **Payback Classes:** Payback classes will be offered at selected shows throughout the year. The Association reserves the right to cancel payback options if less than five (5) entries in the class/division. Additional entry fees will apply.

RING A

Blue/Red Ribbon Schooling 2'6"/2'9"/3'0"-NOT RATED

Open to horses and ponies. Class will remain open throughout the day. One trip per horse/rider combination. Height of fences will not be changed to accommodate rider. Class (17) Blue/Red Ribbon Schooling O/F.

Stepping Stone Working Hunter 2'9" - RATED

Open to horse/ponies. Fences 2'9". Any 2'6" division can enter this class at 2'9" but cannot go on to a 3'0 class at the same show. You may enter at 2'9 "and are eligible to move on to 3'0", but cannot move down to 2'6". (You may step forward one position for 2'6" horses or step back one position for 3'0" horses.) Ponies not to be penalized for added strides per judge's discretion. Class (31) Stepping Stone Hunter O/F, (32) Stepping Stone Hunter O/F, (33) Stepping Stone Hunter U/S.

Children' Equitation 3'0 - RATED

Open to horses/ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. One rider per horse. . Class may be combined with Adult Amateur Equitation 3'0"" classes if there are less than 3 riders; points to accrue separately for year end points. Fences 3'0 Class (9) – Children's Equitation O/F, (10) Children's Equitation U/S

Children's Hunter 3'0"-RATED

Open to horse/ponies shown by Junior Exhibitor. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners. Children's Hunter jump 3'0". Horse/rider combination may not jump fences below 2'9" at the same show. Size of rider to mount with suitability stressed. Class (11) Children's Working Hunter O/F, (12) Children's Working Hunter O/F, (13) Children's Working Hunter U/S.

Adult Amateur Equitation 3'0 - RATED

Open to horses/ponies ridden by an Adult Amateur. One rider per horse. Class may be combined with Children's Equitation 3'0" classes if there are less than 3 riders; points to accrue separately for year end points. Fences 3'0 Class (14) – AA Equitation O/F, (15) AA Equitation U/S

Adult Amateur Working Hunter 3'0 - RATED

Open to horses/ponies ridden by an adult amateur. Fences 3'0. Horse/rider combination may not jump fences below 2'9" at the same show. Class (6)- A/A Working Hunter O/F, (7)- A/A Working Hunter O/F, (8)- A/A Working Hunter U/S

Low Working Hunter 2'6" – RATED

Open to all horses and ponies with any rider. Adults may ride ponies in this division. Fences 2'6". Class (97) Low Working Hunter O/F, (98) Low Working Hunter O/F, (99) Low Working Hunter U/S.

Pre-Adult Equitation 2'6"- RATED

Open to horses/ponies ridden by an Adult Amateur, suitability to count. Horse/Rider combination not eligible for Rated classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6" except Stepping Stone Working Htr. One rider per horse. Class may be combined with Pre-Children Equitation 2'6" classes if there are less than 3 riders; points to accrue separately for year end points. Class (21) Pre-Adult Equitation O/F, (22) Pre-Adult Equitation U/S.

Pre-Adult Hunter 2'6" - RATED

Open to horses/ponies ridden by an Adult Amateur, suitability to count. Horse/Rider combination not eligible for Rated classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6" except Stepping Stone Wrkin Htr. No "in and outs". Class (23) Pre-Adult Hunter O/F, (24) Pre-Adult Hunter O/F, (25) Pre-Adult U/S.

Pre-Children's Equitation 2'6"- RATED

Open to horses/ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor, suitability to count. Horse/Rider combination not eligible for Rated classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6" except Stepping Stone Working Hunter. One rider per horse. Class may be combined with Pre-Adult Equitation 2'6" classes if there are less than 3 riders; points to accrue separately for year end points. Class (18) Pre-Child Equitation O/F, (19) Pre-Child/Equitation U/S.

Pre-Children's Hunter 2'6"-RATED

Open to horses/ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor, suitability to count. Fences 2'6", Horse/Rider combination not eligible for Rated classes at the same show where fence height exceeds 2'6" except Stepping Stone. Class (28) Pre-Child Hunter O/F, (29) Pre-Child Hunter O/F, (30) Pre-Child Hunter U/S.

Open Hunter Pleasure Horse- RATED

Open to horses with no restriction on rider. Suitability to count. To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk, trot and canter. May be asked to hand gallop. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners. Class (192) Open Hunter Pleasure Horse.

RING B

JUMPER DIVISIONS

All Jumper divisions will be ADD-BACK Classes. Entry Fee \$20.00 per class with 50% paid back money. Paid back to top 4 places – 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%. NO horse may jump in more than 4 jumper classes per show.

Hopeful Jumper 2'6"- RATED

Open to all horses and ponies. Fences 2'6, spread not to exceed fence height. Class (108, 109) Hopeful Jumper-Time first jump off

Schooling Jumper 2'9"-3'0" – RATED

Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2'9" to 3'0" with a 3'0" maximum spread. Class (110, 111) Schooling Jumper

Training Jumper 3'0"-3'3" – RATED

Open to horses and ponies. Fences 3'0" – 3'3" with a 3'0" maximum spread. Class (112,113) Training Jumper

.RING C

Blue/Red Ribbon Schooling 2'0"/2'3"/2'6" - NOT RATED

Class (56) Blue/Red ribbon Schooling Warm-Up O/F. Class will remain open throughout day. One trip per rider/horse combination. Height of fences will not be changed to accommodate rider.

Junior/Amateur Adult Equitation 2'0" - RATED

Open to junior and adult amateur riders showing at 2'0". One rider per mount. No "in and outs." Class (57) Jr/AA Equitation O/F. (58) Jr/AA Amateur Equitation U/S.

Beginner Rider Hunter 2'0" - RATED

Open to inexperienced riders who have not competed over fences exceeding 2'0". No "in and outs." Rider may not jump in any class with fence height exceeding 2'0 at the same show. Class (59) Beginner Rider Htr O/F. (60) Beginner Rider Htr O/F.(61) Beginner Rider Htr U/S.

Open Hunter Pleasure Pony - RATED

Open to ponies with no restriction on rider. Suitability to count. To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk, trot and canter. May be asked to hand gallop. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners. Class (191) Open Hunter Pleasure Pony

Schooling Pony Hunter – RATED

Open to all ponies 14.2 hands and under, shown by a junior exhibitor. Manners and suitability to count. Extreme speed penalized. Fences 2' or 2'3" or 2'6" – ponies may enter at the height of their choice. Class (68) Schooling Pony Hunter U/S, (69) Schooling Pony Hunter O/F, (70) Schooling Pony Hunter O/F.

Beginning Hunter 2'0" RATED

Open to inexperienced horses/ponies in their first and second year of showing at fence height of 2'0". Adults may ride ponies, suitability to count. Horse/pony may not show in any division at the same show where fence height exceeds 2'3". Fences 2'0". Class (62) Beginning Htr O/F, (63) Beginning Htr O/F, (64) Beginning Htr U/S.

Junior/Amateur Adult Equitation 2'3" - RATED

Open to junior and adult amateur riders showing at 2'3". One rider per mount. No "in and outs." Class (40) Jr/AA Equitation O/F, (41) Jr/AA Equitation U/S.

Intermediate Working Hunter 2'3" - RATED

Open to horses/ponies. Horse/pony may not show in any division at the same show where fence height exceeds 2'3". No "in and outs." Class (65) Intermediate Wrk Htr O/F, (66) Intermediate Wrk Htr O/F, (67) Intermediate Wrk Htr U/S.

RING D

Model Pony - RATED

Open to Ponies. To be judged on conformation, soundness and way of going. May be shown by juniors or adults. Class (79) Model Pony.

Model Horse - RATED

Open to Horses. To be judged on conformation, soundness and way of going. May be shown by juniors or adults. Class (80) Model Horse.

Blue/Red Ribbon Schooling Crossrails & Short Stirrup 1'9" - NOT RATED

Class (82) Blue/Red Ribbon Schooling Warm-Up O/F. Class will remain open throughout day. One trip per rider/horse combination. Height of fences will not be changed to accommodate rider.

Short Stirrup Equitation 1'9" - RATED

Open to horses/ponies with inexperienced riders 12 years of age and under. (See Short Stirrup Hunter for limitations) To be judged at the walk, trot, and canter in both directions. Class (51) Short Stirrup Warm Up 1'9" O/F., (52) Short Stirrup Warm Up 1'9" U/S.

Short Stirrup Working Hunter 1'9" - RATED

Open to horses/ponies with inexperienced riders 12 years of age and under. Once a rider competes over fences exceeding 1'9" in any show he/she is not eligible for Short Stirrup. Riders may not show in any other division than the following: Short Stirrup Equitation, Equitation 11 and Under U/S, Crossrails, Model or Pleasure. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners and suitability. Extreme speed penalized. Class (53) Short Stirrup Wrk Htr 1'9" O/F., (54) Short Stirrup Wrk Htr 1'9" O/F, (55) Short Stirrup Wrk Htr 1'9" U/S.

Leadline- NOT RATED

Open to horses/ponies with children leadline riders. Class (81) Leadline

Walk - NOT RATED

Open to riders 14 years of age and under (as of Jan 1). If an exhibitor has cantered at any show, he/she is no longer eligible for this class. May show ponies or horses. Class (43A) Walk Equitation Under 14, (43B) Walk U/S Under 14.

Children's Walk/Trot Divisions - RATED

Open to Junior exhibitors 14 years of age and under (as of Jan 1). If an exhibitor has cantered at any other show, he/she is no longer eligible for this class. May show ponies or horses. Classes may be combined if not enough competitors to fill classes. **Points to accrue to the rider as it is possible for a child in this division to ride multiple horses – RIDER MUST BE A MEMBER TO ACCRUE YEAR END POINTS.** Class (83) Walk Trot Equitation 9 & Under, (84) Walk Trot Hunter U/S 9 & Under, (85) Walk Trot Pleasure. 9 & Under, Class (86) Walk Trot Equitation 10-14, (87) Walk Trot Hunter U/S 10-14, (88) Walk Trot Pleasure 10-14

Adult Walk/Trot Division - RATED

Open to Adult exhibitors 15 years of age and over (as of Jan 1). If an exhibitor has cantered at any other show, he/she is no longer eligible for this class. May show ponies or horses. Points to accrue to the horse/rider combination. Class (44) Walk Trot Equitation, (45) Walk Trot Hunter U/S, (46) Walk Trot Pleasure.

Crossrails Hunter Walk & Trot- RATED

Open to inexperienced horses/ponies and/or riders. Once the horse/rider combination competes successfully over fences at the canter they may no longer compete in this division.. No "in and outs". May trot over fences. Points to accrue to the horse/rider combination. Class (90) Crossrails Hunter W/T O/F, (91) Crossrails Htr W/T O/F, (92) Crossrails Htr W/T U/S.

Crossrails Hunter – RATED

Open to inexperienced horses/ponies and/or riders. Riders may compete in this division for only two years. Once the horse/rider combination competes over fences exceeding 2', they may no longer compete in this division. No "in and outs". May trot or canter over fences. Under Saddle class will include walk, trot, and canter. Points to accrue to the horse/rider combination. Class (94) 'Crossrails Htr W/T/C O/F (95) Crossrails Htr W/T/C O/F.(96) Crossrails Htr W/T/C U/S.

Limited Flat – RATED

Open to horses/ponies ridden by a Junior or Adult Amateur. Suitability to count. Shown at a walk, trot, and canter. Horse/rider may NOT enter any jumping classes AT THE SAME SHOW. Points to accrue to horse/rider combination. Class (1) Limited Jr/AA Equitation Flat, (2) Limited Jr/AA Hunter Flat, (3) Limited Jr/AA Pleasure.
